All Lifeline of Ohio organ recovery cases require a scrub person and a circulating RN. The Organ Recovery Coordinator and Preservationist will be available to help assist the staff to facilitate the smoothest procedure possible for all concerned. Please have all instrument counts completed prior to procedure.

Incoming transplant recovery teams **may** bring specialty instruments needed for their portion of the procedure. These instruments may need to be sterilized prior to use.

Each team will provide the appropriate preservation solutions, tubing, cannulas, and packing materials needed for each organ.

Incoming transplant teams will need assistance back to the ED post recovery.

Absorbent floor covering (cloud) if available.

#### **Patient Position:**

Supine with patients' arms tucked.

In some cases, pt. will be in Supine position with arms out and up (high 90°) above head for access.

### Prep:

Chloroprep or Duraprep (No Blue Tint).

Prep from the chin to the mid-thigh and from table to table laterally.
