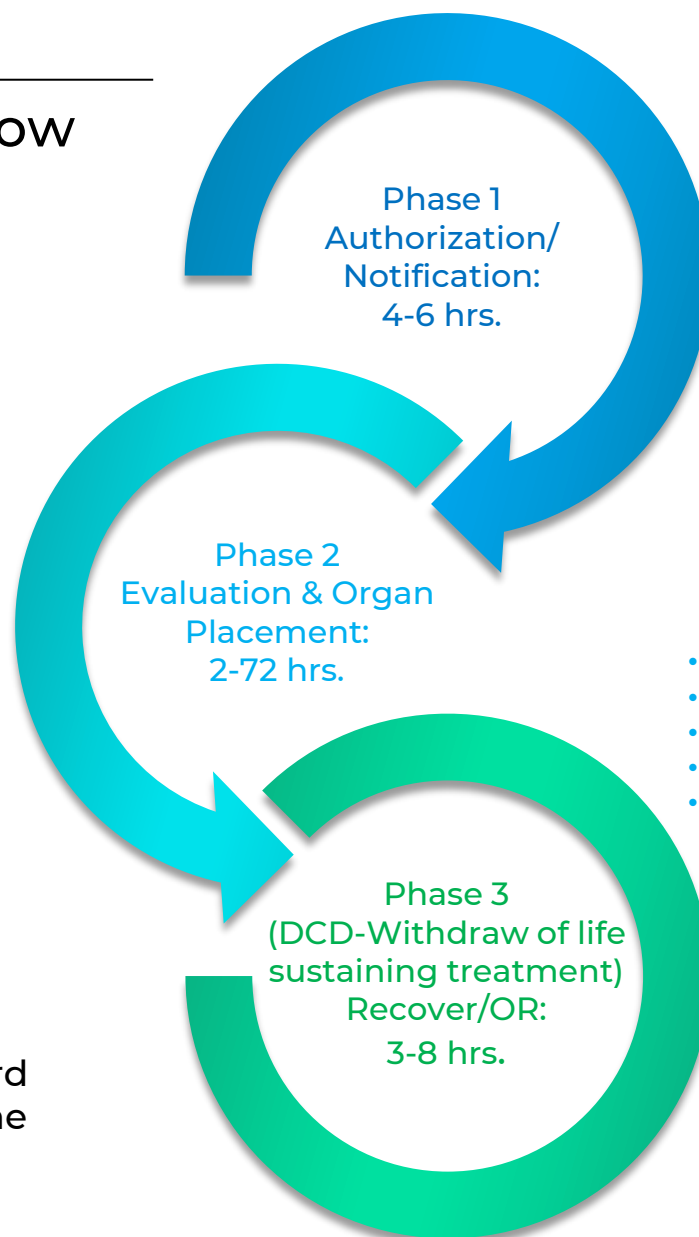


Donation Case Flow

- Phase 1 occurs after family has made end of life decisions or brain death testing has been completed
- Infectious disease genetic testing are collected and run STAT. These tests take approx. 8 hrs. to result.
- Hemodynamic instability changes timelines.

- Huddle/Collaboration prior to approaching Legal Next of Kin
- Lifeline of Ohio assumes financial responsibility of charges associated with donor management
- Lifeline of Ohio is responsible for donor management of a Brain Dead donor and will collaborate with provider for DCD donor management
- Notify coroner/Obtain coroner approval
- RN collects blood tubes for tissue typing/infectious disease testing/coroner (Lifeline Coordinator will label tubes)
- Placement of arterial Line and central Line
- Support/Memory making with family
- Develop plan for Honor Walk
- DCD-Identify pronouncing Physician, identify withdraw location, and family requests
